Dinamo Zagreb Football Club is a Croatian professional football club based in Zagreb. Dinamo play their home matches at Stadion Maksimir. They are the most successful club in Croatian football, having won twenty-three Prva HNL titles, sixteen Croatian Cups, six Croatian Super Cups, and one Inter-Cities Fairs Cup. The club has spent its entire existence in top flight, having been members of the Yugoslav First League from 1946 to 1991, and then the Prva HNL since its foundation in 1993.

Itinerary:

DAY 1 (Friday, July 14)

Arrival. Rest. Depending of the time of the arrival, city tour. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 2 (Saturday, July 15)

Full day Excursion: Visit to Krapina Neanderthal Museum with expert guide, it's place where in 1899. remains of Neanderthal people were found. Krapina town walking tour. Lunch. Visit to Trakošćan castle, which is full of furniture and various artifacts from different periods, and tells the story of life at the court. Tour with expert guide. Returning to Zagreb. Excursion includes: transportation, entrance fees to the museums in Krapina and Trakošćan castle, with guidance, lunch, licensed guide. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 3 (Sunday, July 16)

Full Day Excursion: Visit to Varaždin, a beautiful city in the north Croatia, walk through town with its interesting stories, with local guide. Lunch. Visit to the Museum of the city of Varaždin with the Old Town Museum, Palace Herzer and Palace Sermage, with expert guide. Returning to Zagreb. Excursion includes: transportation, entrance fees to the Museum of the city of Varaždin and Entomological collection, with guidance, Varaždin tour with a local guide, lunch, licensed guide. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 4 (Monday, July 17)

Breakfast. Training at Football Academy. Lunch. Walk through city center with local guide, downtown and upper town, get to know the capital of Croatia with its beauty, green heart, a lots of legends, underground tunnels and interesting museums. Visit to the Museum of illusions with an expert guide (entrance ticket included). Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.



DAY 5 (Tuesday, July 18)

Breakfast. Training at Football Academy. Lunch. Jarun lake visit. South of the city centre is the Jarun lake also called "Zagreb Sea". With its cycle tracks, lakes for water sports and sports grounds for team sports, Jarun lake is the largest entertainment centre in Zagreb. The place is ideal for sunbathing or swimming on hot summer days. During the day the lake is host for walkers and athletes and in the evening nightclubs welcome night creatures. DAY 6 (Wednesday, July 19)

Breakfast. Training at Football Academy. Lunch. Visit to Zagreb ZOO Park (entrance ticket included). The Zagreb Zoo was founded in 1925 and is located in the over 200-year-old Maksimir Park. It covers 7 hectares, of which 5.5 is the land part. It is home to over 368 species of animals and more than 7,182 individuals from all continents. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 7 (Thursday, July 20)

Breakfast. Training at Football Academy. Training at Football Academy. Lunch. Amazinga Amusing Park. Lunch. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 8 (Friday, July 21)

Breakfast. Training at Football Academy. Lunch. A visit to Sljeme with the cable car and a tour of the old town of Medvedgrad. Medvedgrad is a medieval fortified town located on the south slopes of Medvednica mountain, approximately halfway from the Croatian capital Zagreb to the mountain top Sljeme. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 9 (Saturday, July 22)

Breakfast. Full Day Excursion: Visit to NP Plitvička jezera. The Plitvice Lakes is the oldest and the largest national park in the Republic of Croatia. The exceptional natural beauty of this area has always attracted nature lovers. As a result of that, it was declared the first national park of the Republic of Croatia as early as 8 April 1949 and it was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Lunch. Visit ranch „Deer Valley“, as part of OPG Bičanić which was established in 2009., is engaged in breeding red deer and fallow deer. At the ranch are also black Slavonian pigs and three horses. The ranch covers an area of about 15 hectares. Dinner. Overnight in Plitvice.





Itinerary:

DAY 10 (Sunday, July 23)

Breakfast. Transfer to Zadar. Zadar is a city of romance and love, as well as a place of passion and spirit! This is a town that does not mind exploring new art forms and ideas to enrich its extraordinary setting and complement its grand physique. Lunch. Visit Greeting to the Sun and Sea Organs, St. Donatus. Transfer to Zagreb. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 11 (Monday, July 25)

Breakfast. Going for swimming at Zagrabian swimming pool. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.

DAY 12 (Tuesday, July 26)

Breakfast. Full Day Excursion: Visit to Samobor. Samobor is a delightful little town located only about 25km away from the centre of Zagreb. The town is most famous for its kremšnita cream cake. Over the centuries, Samobor has also been celebrated for its craftsmakers and artisans involved in the production of various goods – clothing, hats, leather items, licitar hearts, crystal items and more. The main square in the town features a number of historic buildings, including the town hall. A well is also situated here – drink from the well, legend says, and you will always return to Samobor. Samobor Castle is built in 1268 by the forces of Czech King Ottokar II of Bohemia. The castle had been in use from the 13th to 18th centuries – added to considerably by its various owners during this time – but the castle's decline started when its last residents left in the 18th century. The Castle came to be under the ownership of the town in 1902 and today is little more than a ruin. Excursion includes: transportation, lunch. Dinner. Overnight in Zagreb.



DAY 13 (Wednesday, July 27)

Breakfast. A visit to Nikola Tesla Museum with Planetarium and Mine. Lunch. A visit to the Museum of Contemporary Art where, in addition to visiting the exhibition, you can visit Summer at MSU (Museum of Contemporary Arts). For seven consecutive summers, the Museum of Contemporary Arts brings a perfect blend of top artistic content under the principle '4 in 1' – or better said 'music, film, exhibitions, performances and book readings'. The museum's roof, garage and the plateau at the slope of the museum become concert venues and this year there will be six concerts held by the best bands of the region. Free time in the city center for shopping and enjoying Zagreb. Airport transfer.
